

IMPORTANT NOTICE

FEMA / NFIP Flood Insurance Training Requirements

Section 207 of the Flood Insurance Reform Act of 2004, Public Law 108-264, requires all agents selling flood insurance policies under the NFIP or through a WYO company, to be properly trained and educated about the NFIP so that they may properly serve their clients.

Failing to comply with the NFIP education requirement could jeopardize an agent's authority to write insurance through the National Flood Insurance Program, in addition to increasing your agency's E & O exposure.

FEMA Regional Offices conduct NFIP Agent Workshop/Training Classes in cities throughout the country. Go to http://coop.fema.gov/business/nfip/a wshop.shtm for details on a workshop in your area.
